Alcoholics Anonymous does not finance or lends its name to any outside organization. The SSAC is an outside organization, separate and distinct from A.A., Al-anon or any other 12-Step group. The SSAC is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors elected from club membership. The SSAC membership is open to all and is independent of any of the various groups or meetings that pay rent to help defray operational expenses. The SSAC members include alcoholics and addicts attending meetings. And the family and friends in recovery attending Al-anon meetings at the house who support the objectives of the SSAC.

SECTION II MEMBERSHIP

A. Eligibility: The Primary requirements for Membership in the Club are:

1. Any member who has been, and is currently, in good standing with any regular Twelve Step Program for at least 30 days is eligible for membership.
2. Support of the Club through voluntary contributions.
3. Spouses/significant others of the above parties can also become members.

B. Dues:

Membership is due on the 1st. Day of each month. Any member who has not paid dues for 2 consecutive months shall be dropped from the membership roll.

Individuals can reinstate their membership by resuming monthly dues.

1. All new and/or reinstated members will be required to be dues paying members for thirty (30) days before being eligible to vote at membership or election meetings.

C. Facility Use:

1. All privileges and Club facilities shall be available to all members, their spouses/significant others, and minor children.
2. Any guest by members invitation or function ticket purchase.
3. Any member or person in recovery attending closed meetings.
4. Any person attending an open meeting.
5. Any person using the Club must abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Club.

SECTION III LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

A. Mandatory Loss of Privileges:

1. Bringing on the premises any alcohol, controlled substance, drug paraphernalia or weapons.

B. Discretionary Loss of Membership:

1. The Board of Directors shall have the discretion and the power to suspend or terminate the membership privileges and rights of any member for the following reasons:
 - a. For exhibiting behaviors that are considered hostile to the objectives of the Club.
 - b. For exhibiting behaviors that are considered injurious to the Charter of the Club.
 - c. Any infraction of the Rules and Regulations of the Club.
 - d. Failure to maintain monthly contributions for three (3) consecutive months.Any person thus suspended that doesn't adhere to the suspension shall be legally restricted through court order from the properties of the Club. Continued lack of noncompliance will result in permanent expulsion.
2. The board of Directors has the power to temporarily suspend suspend the monthly contributions of a member for medical, physical or financial needs. Such member's rights shall be kept in good standing.

C. Reinstatement of Membership:

1. Meeting membership eligibility.
2. The Board of Directors shall have the discretionary power to set the terms and conditions of each suspension or termination of any member.
